

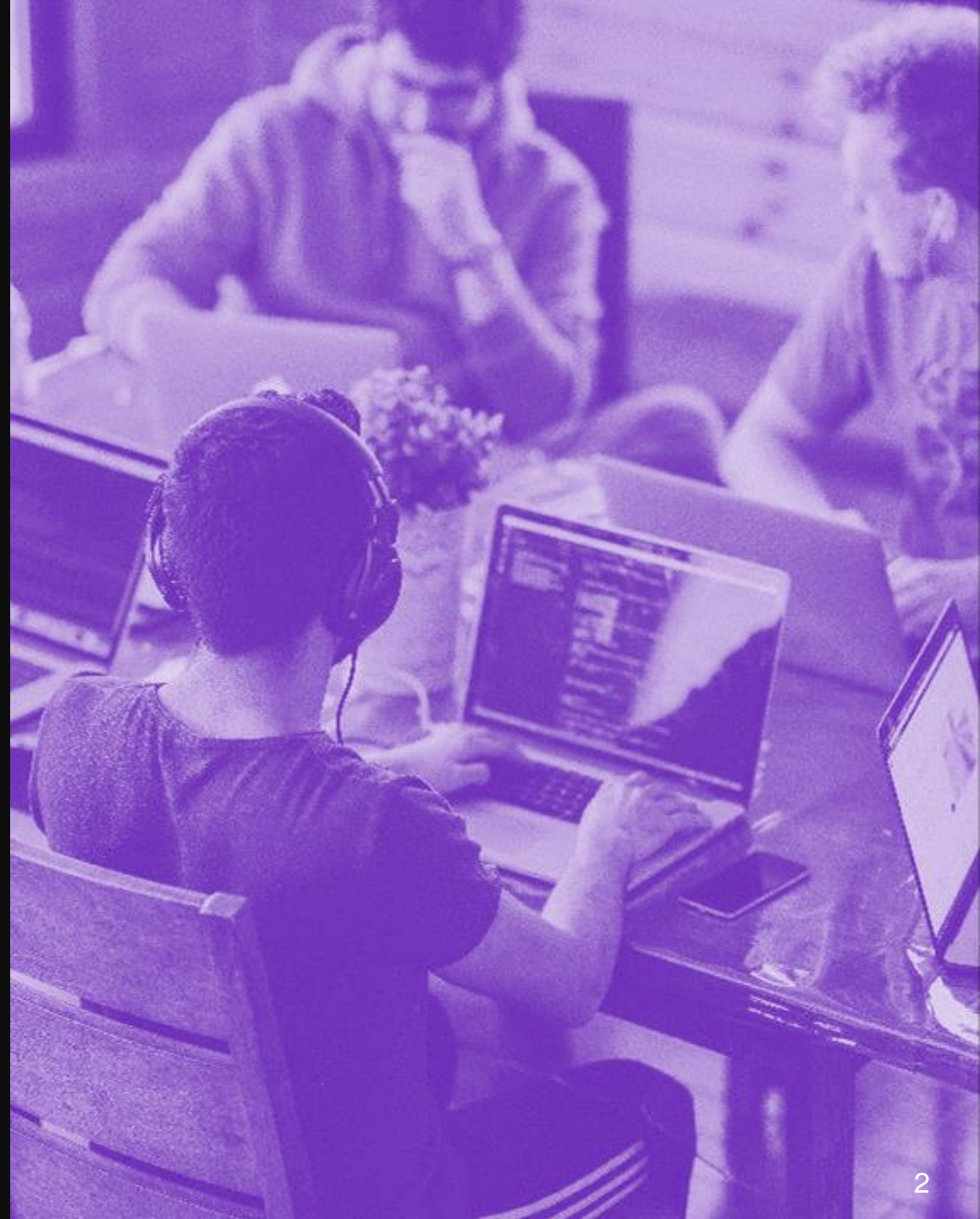

Coming from a tech background, John values teamwork, especially in multidisciplinary settings. He is open to learning from others in the health field and combining different perspectives to create innovative solutions.

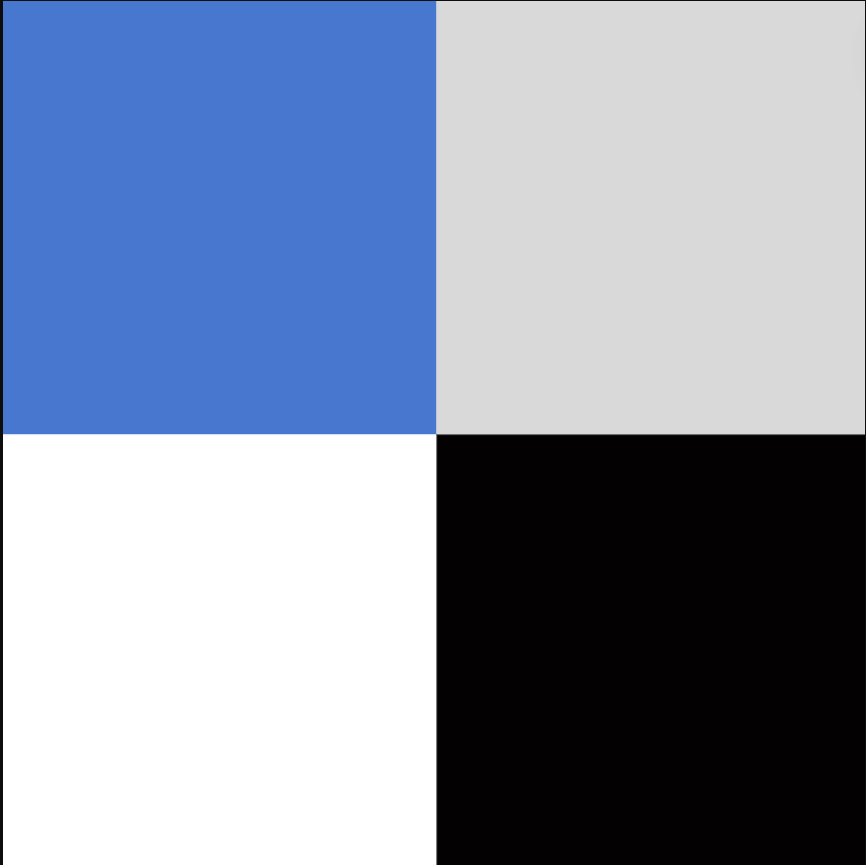

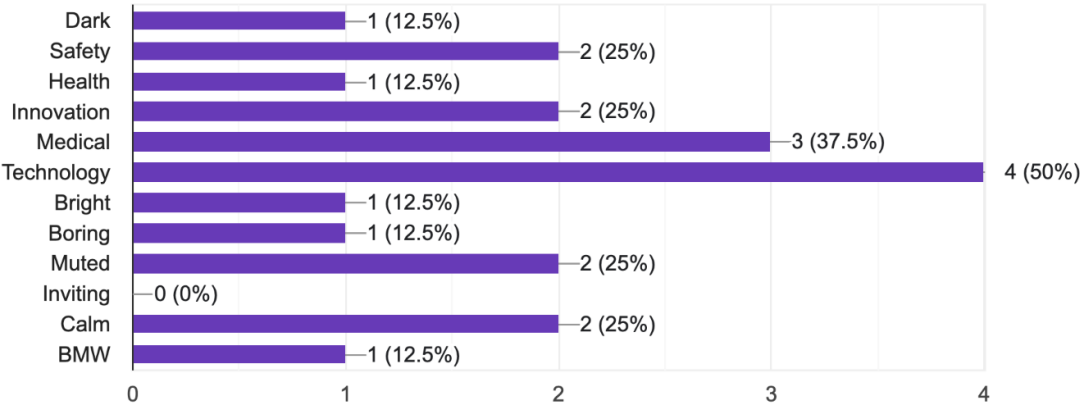
- As a tech-focused student, John might find it challenging to communicate or collaborate with peers from medical or health backgrounds who may not fully understand the tech side.

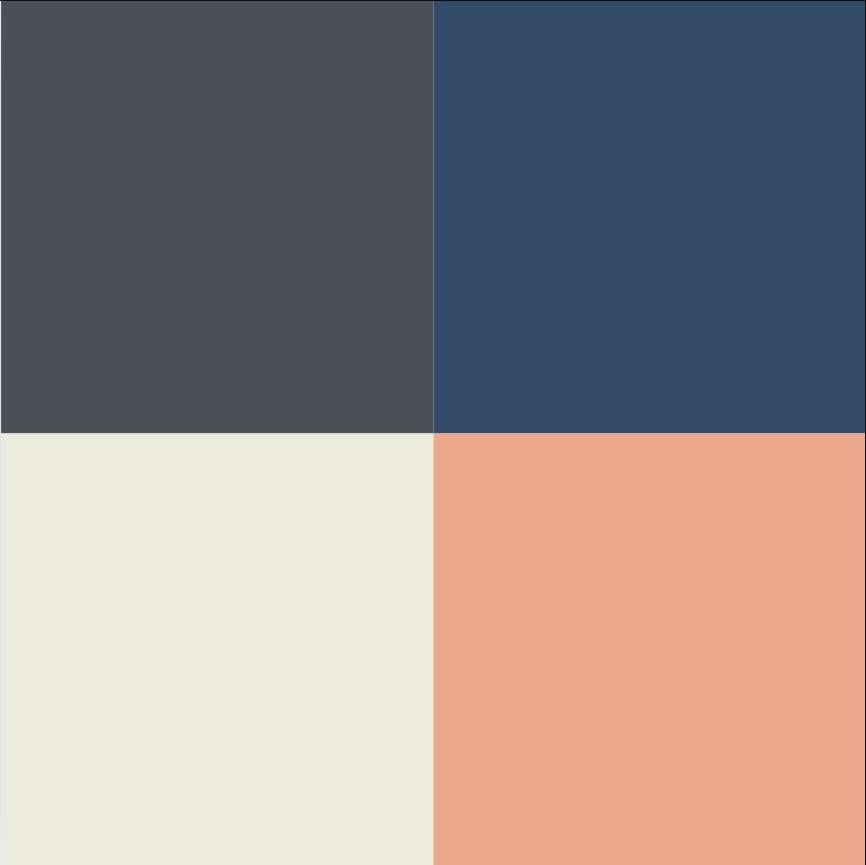
John is used to the fast-paced nature of ICT projects, where results and feedback are often immediate. In health innovation, progress can be slower.



Which adjectives do you feel best describe the following colour palette?

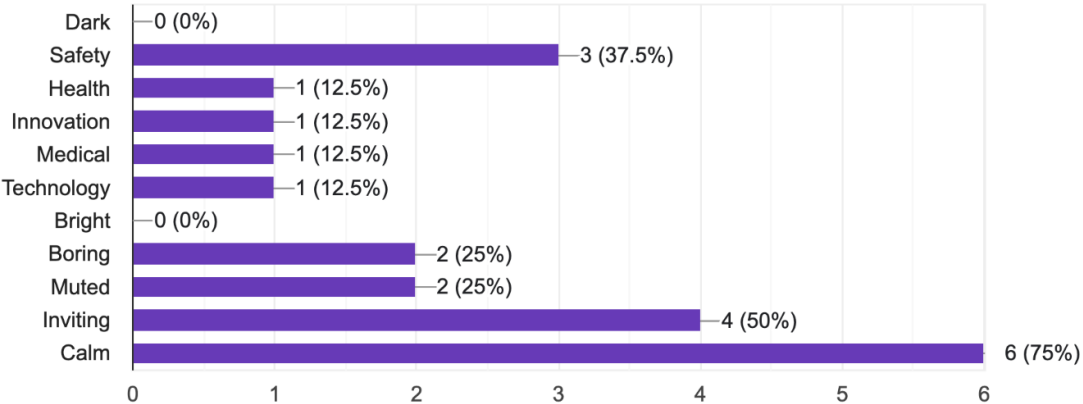

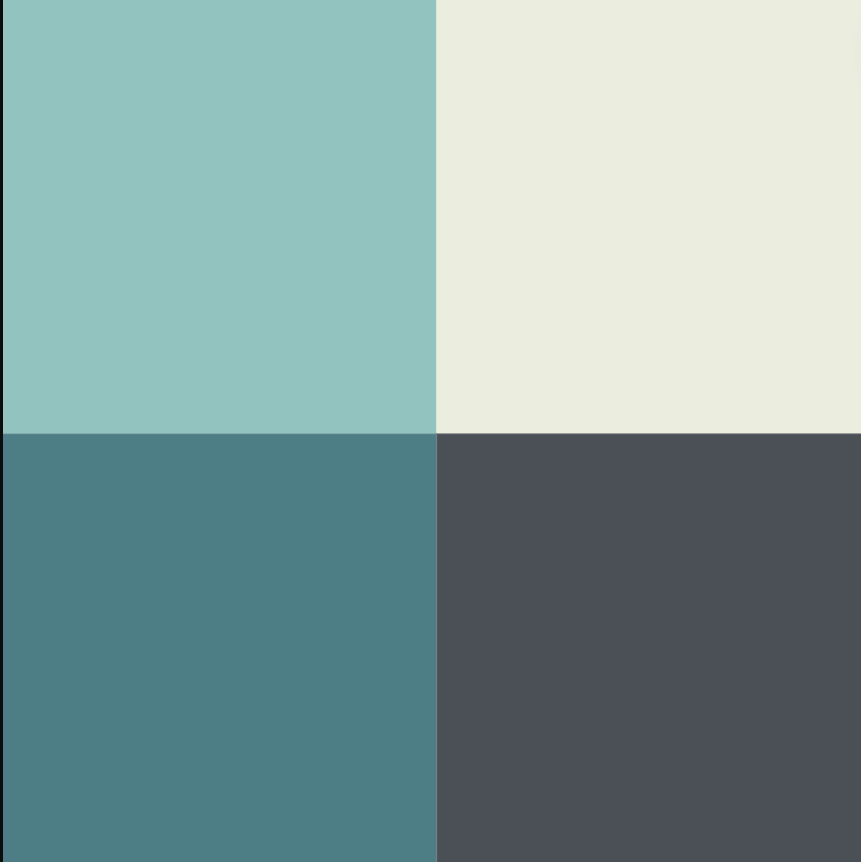




Which adjectives do you feel best describe the following colour palette?

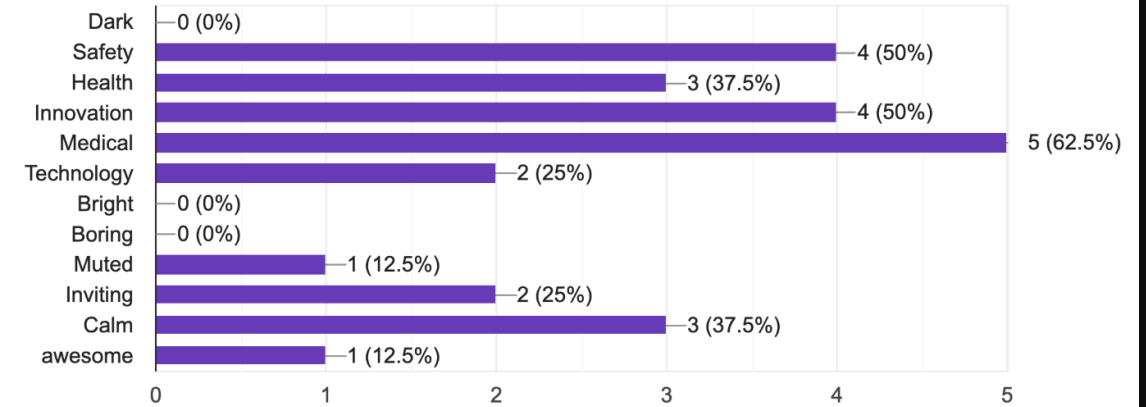

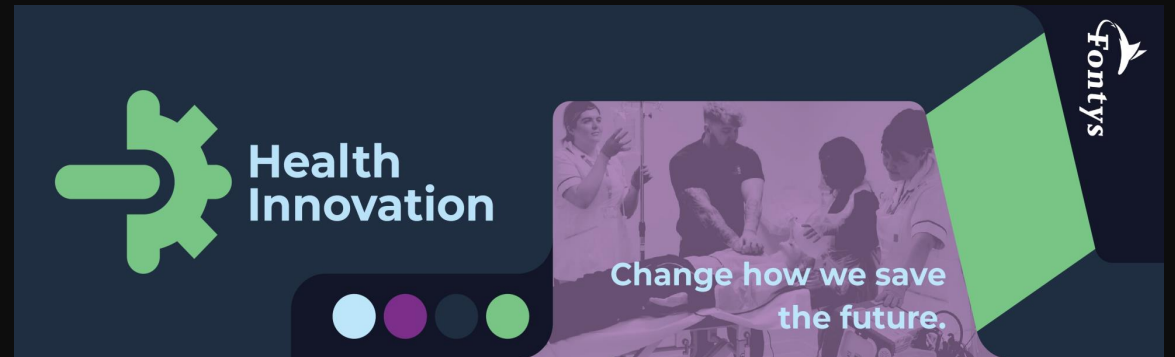
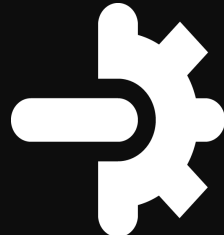
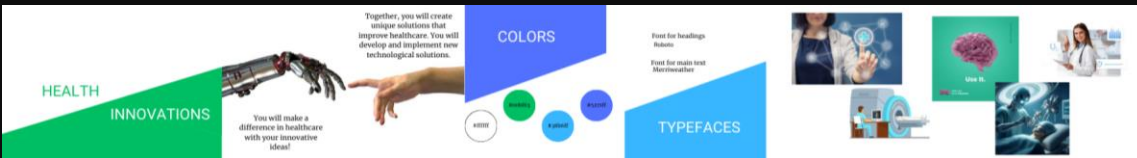




Which adjectives do you feel best describe the following colour palette?

Thanks for the first draft, by the looks of it you guys have been hard at work.

Some aspects that I find strong:

(Mila) The alternation between photos and information in outline 1 (orange blue) In this, bite-sized bits of info seem to be interspersed with attractive images. In this outline, the combination of color is also appropriate. It does not deviate much from the Fontys house style, but it does deviate a bit deliberately. The addition of photographs also gives this set-up a personal character. The schematic lamp with care cross in the middle is a nice variation on the lamp we have.

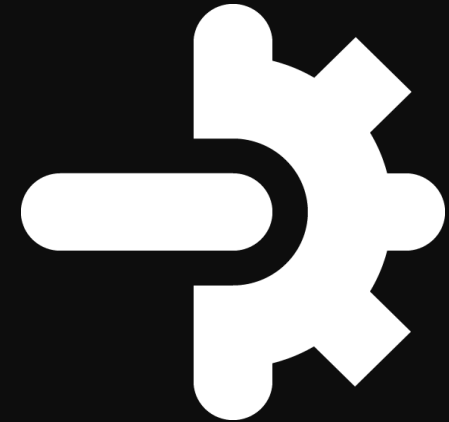
(Okan) The together for the future setup is a bit on the busy side but it is very nice that you have different drawn figures coming back, it makes it look like a whole. I can also imagine that this is easy to incorporate in different types of media to convey one image. Nice that the color purple returns in this so that we do not deviate too much from the Fontys shades.

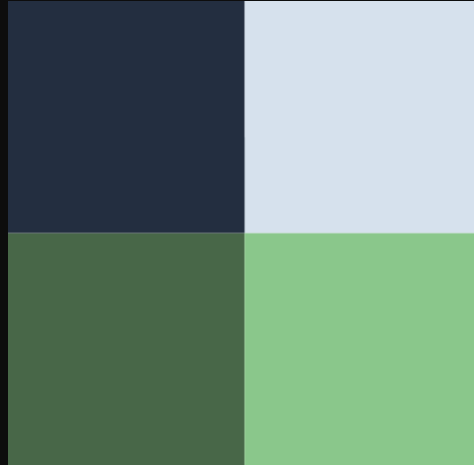

This makes it more difficult to communicate an image. Beautiful images though. In terms of colors, adding purple would be my preference.

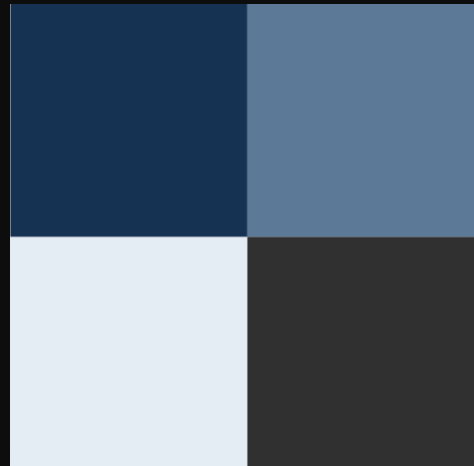

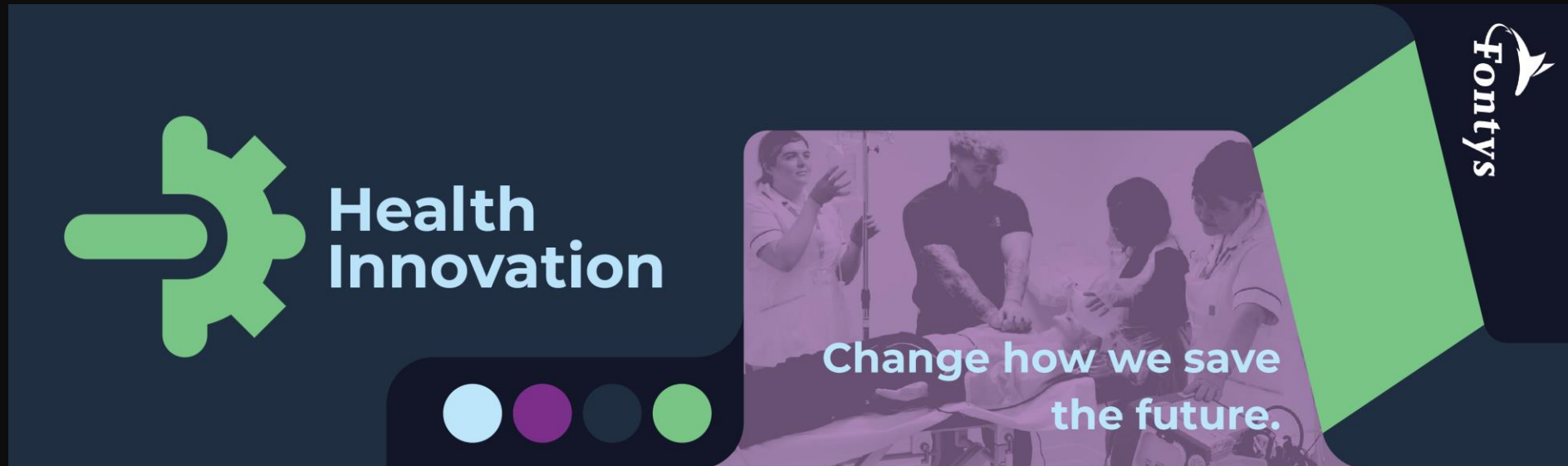
